



Engineered material made from natural quartz that is ground up into powder and mixed with resins, polymers, and pigments that color the stone. It is more resistant to damage than natural stone, with the exception of its sensitivity to heat and UV rays. Quartz is stain and scratch-resistant. Limestone

MAINTENANCE / CARE


Limestone is a sedimentary rock composed of calcite (a calcium carbonate mineral). One of the most significant advantages of using limestone in interior design is its durability and resilience. Limestone is a dense, hard-wearing stone that can withstand heavy foot traffic and resist scratches and stains. It is ideal for high-traffic areas like kitchens and bathrooms, where durability is essential.



Travertine

MAINTENANCE / CARE

Travertine is a type of limestone that precipitates from hydrothermal springs. It features soft, layered patterning and can be found in white-gray, golden-brown, sandy yellow, tan/beige, and red colorations. Instead of dramatic veining, travertine offers more subtle, calming movement and visual texture.



Onyx

MAINTENANCE / CARE

Onyx is an agate gemstone that can be found in every color of the rainbow, although black and red onyxes are rarer. Onyx is a beautiful fine grained stone with distinctive patterns. It is highly desirable for its unique appearance and is a popular choice as it adds a truly special touch. Onyx stones stand out because they are translucent.

Slate

MAINTENANCE / CARE

Slate is a metamorphic rock containing foliated layers of fine dark grey to black mica. A bit brittle in nature, it's not as durable as some other stones like marble or granite and can be sharp around the edges. However, it is non-porous, making it great for showers, sinks, and outdoor applications. It comes in lovely shades of charcoal, gray, pewter, brown.
